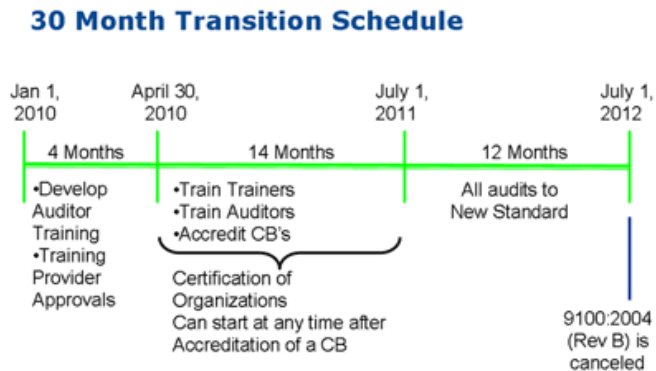


Client Notification: Aerospace Transition to the New 2009 Version of the AS9100/9110/9120 Standard

All Orion Registrar aerospace clients will be required to transition from the current version of the AS9100/9110/9120 Quality Management System Standard to the 2009 version of the standard. The schedule for this transition is shown in the diagram below.

The IAQG recently published the Transition Schedule for Transitioning to the 2009 versions of Aerospace Quality Management Systems Standards (9100/9110/9120). An overall schedule is shown to the right. The IAQG Other Party Management (OPMT) has also established supplemental rules for transition details and they can be viewed at: [Supplemental Rules for Transition To 2009 AQMS Standards](#)



The general requirements for this transition to the new standard follow:

1. The days for all 9100/9110/9120:2009 transition audits shall be as follows:
 - a. Transition during surveillance audit using 50% of initial audit day requirements of IAF MD 5 and 100% of the initial audit day requirements of table 2 of 9104.
 - b. Transition during recertification audit using 80% of initial audit day requirements of IAF MD 5 and 100% of the initial audit day requirements of table 2 of 9104.
2. In addition, it is the responsibility of the CB to identify additional days that may be required to audit the new requirements of the 9100/9110/9120:2009 standards and complete the 9101:2009 (AS9101 Rev D) audit report.
